Responsibilities

- ◆ To participate in setting the organizational Web development strategy.
- ◆ To develop and communicate Web site usage, security policies, standards, architecture, and overall structure.
- ◆ To identify, recommend, and prioritize new Web features and applications.
- ◆ To develop, code, install, test, debug, and document Web applications using appropriate editors.
- ◆ To establish policies and procedures for publishing Web pages and applications in conjunction with content creators.
- ◆ To update Web pages to ensure site accuracy and currency.
- ◆ To diagnose and troubleshoot problems with existing Web applications and sites.
- ◆ To monitor and report on Web site traffic and performance.
- ◆ To perform cost-benefit analyses of proposed Web implementations.

Support Raising

- ◆ Each staff member recruits a team of people to financially support their living expenses.
- ◆ Raising the full support needed to cover their income is each staff person's initial task.
